# Practical experience with Remedy+ Yeastosol.



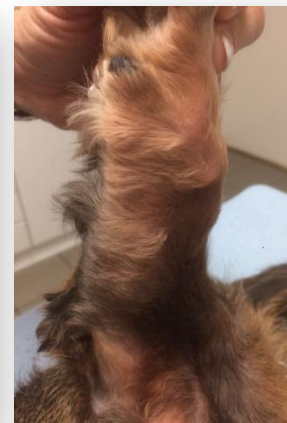
**CASE.** The diagnosis and treatment of yeast dermatitis (*Malassezia pachydermatis*). The infection was located at the medial side of the two front paws. The dachshund's name is Kwibus.

**KWIBUS.** Rough haired dachshund, male, 6 years, with recurring yeast infections on both front legs. The skin is thickened and shows acanthose, erythema and flakes.

**DIAGNOSIS.** The presence of yeasts has been demonstrated by means of a cytology.

**HOW.** Owner treated Kwibus by applying the HFL Remedy + Yeastosol spray to the yeast area every day. No additional products such as shampoo for the yeasts were used for this but Apoquel was used for itching.

**RESULT.** After 2 weeks of daily treatment with Yeastosol, the skin is no longer thickened, the erythema is gone. After treatment: as prevention/maintenance Yeastosol is used twice a week. The yeasts stayed away. There is no more itching!



**THE PRODUCT.** Yeastosol is a safe spray that kills the yeasts. Without the addition of antibiotics or hormones. Until now, the treatment against yeasts consisted of regular washing with an anti-yeast shampoo (washing, rinsing and drying) or an oral treatment with an anti-yeast medication. These azoles have the side effect of being hepatotoxic. (can cause liver damage).

**PROFESSIONAL OPINION.** I find that the Remedy + Yeastosol is an easy and effective product to treat *Malassezia pachydermatis* in case of allergic dogs.
